What is WebSpirit?

- An affordable electronic data capture and clinical trial management system
- Built for the Australian trials environment to GCP requirements
- Data are stored on an Australian server and are backed up daily
- A dedicated Database Manager based in Melbourne provides support and training
- Easily build your own electronic case report forms, use ready-made forms or commission the Database Manager to build them for you.

WebSpirit was developed with Commonwealth Government funding through the National Collaborative Research Infrastructure Strategy and is managed by the Paediatric Trials Network Australia. It is part of the Australian Therapeutic Pipeline, a consortium of over 25 of Australia's leading translational research facilities.

Who can use WebSpirit?

WebSpirit is available to all in the research community, not just those involved in paediatric research; from investigator-initiated research through to commercial enterprises.

WebSpirit is suitable for all types of clinical research: paediatric, adult, clinical trials and other clinical studies.

The WebSpirit portal is accessible from anywhere in the world where the internet is available.

WebSpirit is a web-based data management system, custom built for the Australian trials environment. It provides an affordable solution for managing clinical trial and clinical research data, and is available to all in the research community.

EDC

WebSpirit can be used as a electronic data capture system (EDC). The software was built to fulfil Good Clinical Practice requirements, and provides:



- Ability to build your own studies
- Easy access to data
- Capture cleaner clinical data
- Timeline and milestone planning
- Full eCRF capabilities
- Supports electronic signatures
- Monitor SAEs and protocol deviations
- Dedicated support from the WebSpirit Database Manager

CTMS

WebSpirit goes beyond a basic EDC, providing clinical trial management functionality that enables Project Managers to:



- Monitor study progress
- Plan and track study timelines and milestones
- Audit trail for all data entry and modifications
- Centrally monitor data entry; raise and address data queries within a single system
- Oversee up-to-date and accurate study data
- Export data for local analysis
- Manage user access and levels of security

Document management

WebSpirit can be used as a document repository, either within a project or as a stand alone service. This functionality enables:



- Secure storage and sharing of essential documentation
- Tracking of ethics and governance approvals
- Easy access to training materials across all sites
- Pricing available for use of WebSpirit solely as a document repository (from \$180 per annum)

Pricing

WebSpirit runs on a cost-recovery pricing model and is extremely competitive compared to commercially available products.



- Start-up fees from \$5500 – \$6000 AUD/ongoing annual fees from \$4000 AUD*
- Standard charges cover up to 20 users across 10 sites
- Cost includes training and design assistance
- Additional charges for CRF development – starting at \$150 per hour
- Additional charges for extra sites/users – starting at \$20 per site/user
